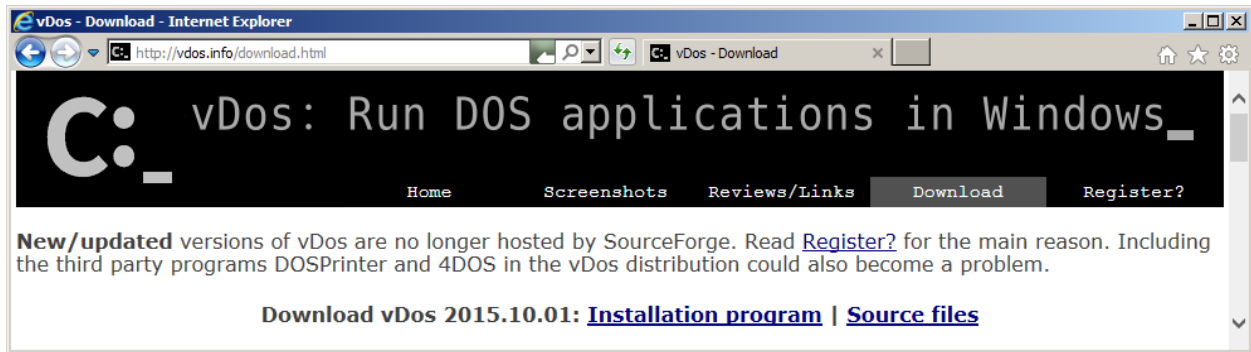
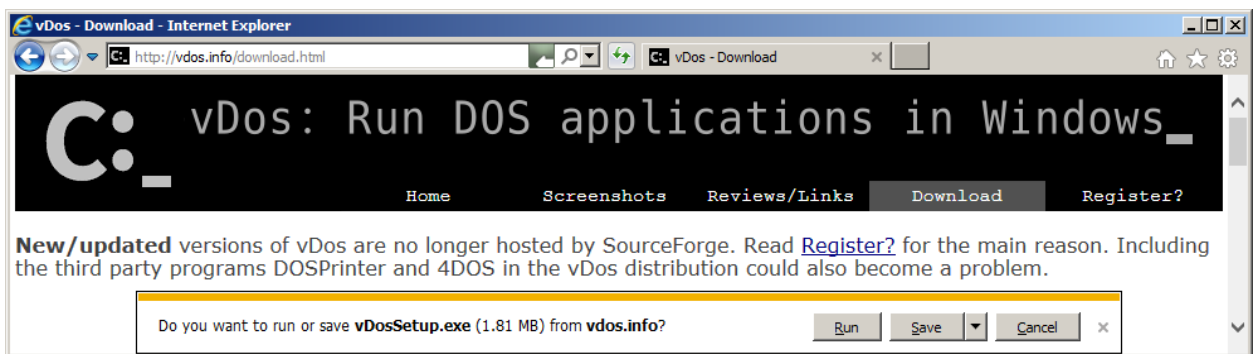


How To Install vDOS and Turbo-TRAX (v7.01 and higher)

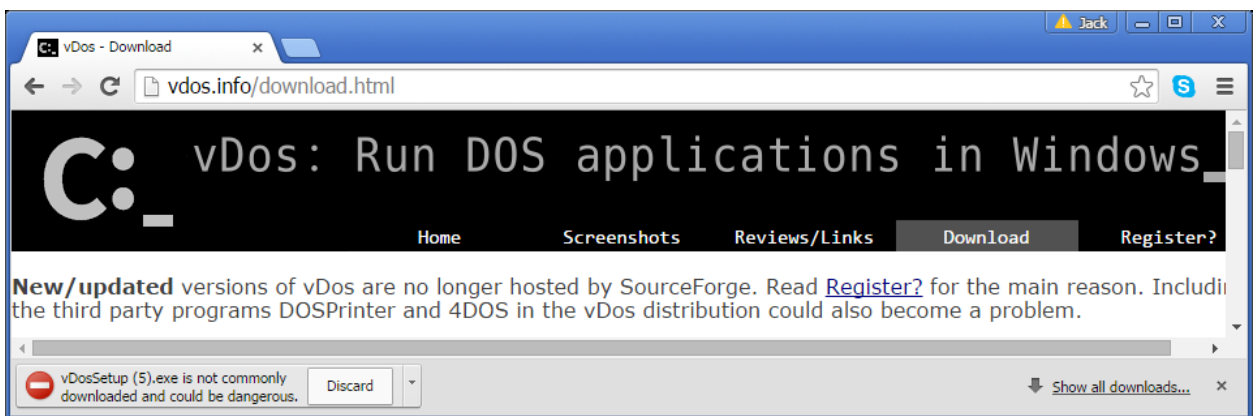
- 1) Use your browser and go to <http://vdos.info/download.html>



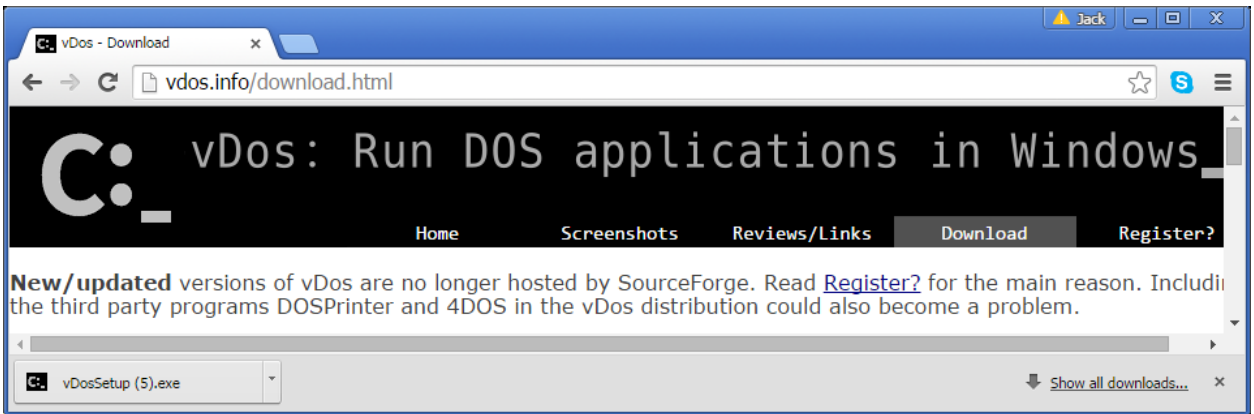
- 2) Click on the link labelled “**Installation program**”. The download should begin.
- 3) As follows: “**Run**” the “vDosSetup.exe” that downloads and follow the screen instructions to install vDOS in c:\vDos.
 - a) In Internet Explorer, click on “Run” button as shown below



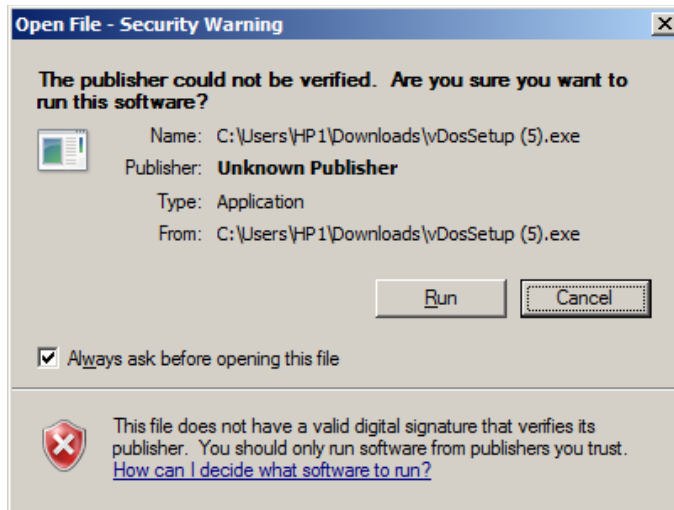
- b) In Google Chrome
 - i. At the bottom left of the window, click on the down arrow to the right of the “Discard” button as shown below, and then click on “Keep”



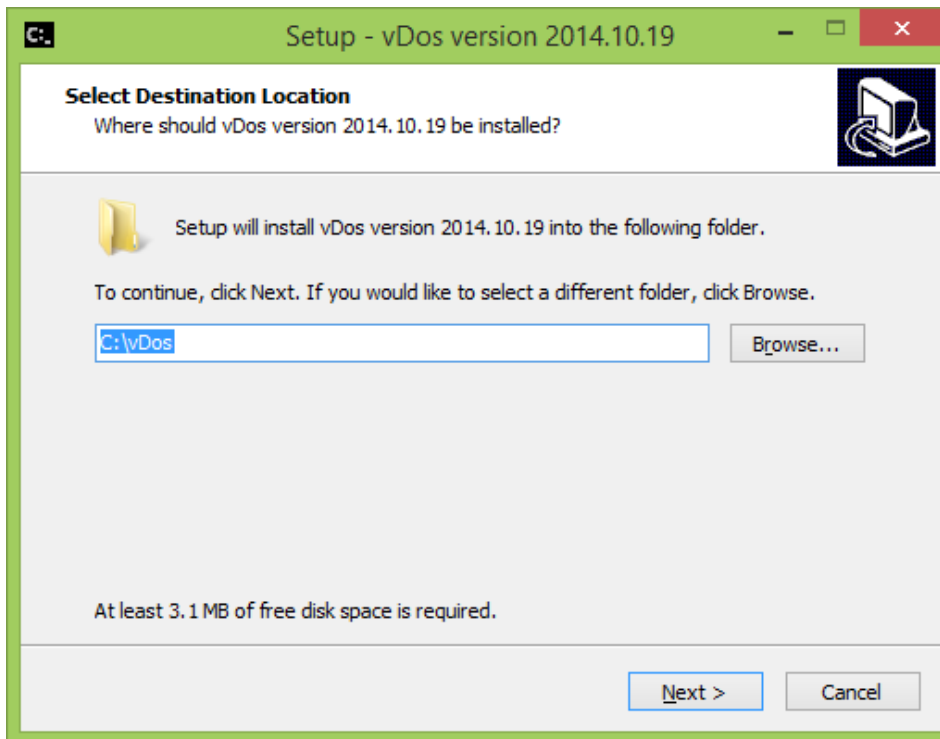
- ii. then click on the button called “vDosSetup.exe” on the bottom left of the window

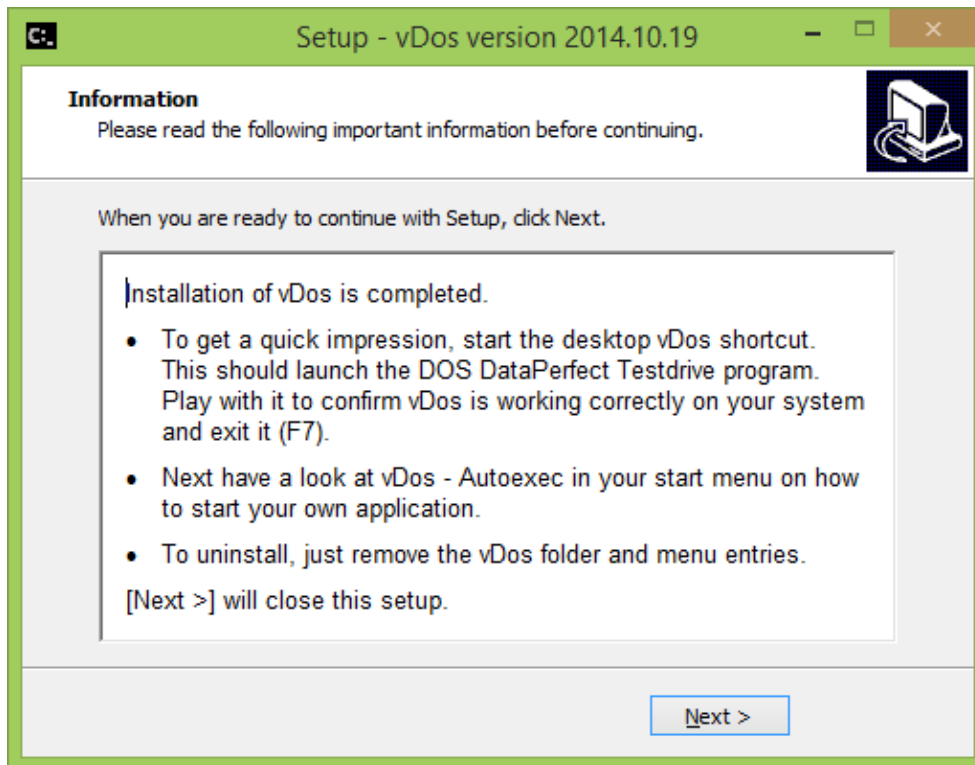


iii. An “Open File – Security Warning” may appear. Click on the “Run” button as shown below:

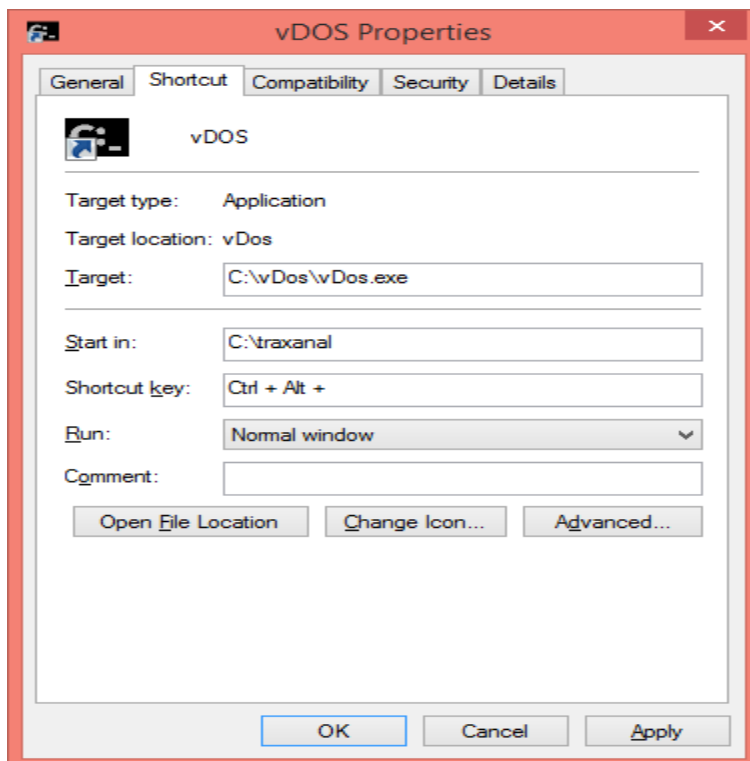


4) A Setup window will appear. As shown in the two screenshots below, you will be clicking on “Next” twice:





- 5) vDos should now be installed and you will see its icon on your desktop. Next step is to install Turbo-TRAX.
- 6) Go to turboschool.com/trax2.htm and follow screen instructions to install Turbo-TRAX in **c:\traxanal**.
- 7) After installing Turbo-TRAX, right-click on your desktop **vDOS** shortcut and select Properties.
- 8) Under the Shortcut tab, change the "**Start in**" field to the text "**C:\Traxanal**" as shown below.



- 9) Click on "**Apply**" and "**OK**".
- 10) Right-click on your **vDOS** desktop shortcut icon and rename it to become "**Turbo-TRAX vDOS**" (**Important step!**)

11) Finally, double-click on the Turbo-TRAX vDOS icon on your desktop. Your Turbo-TRAX program should launch and you can start using Turbo-TRAX. You should never have to repeat steps 1-10 again.

Upgrading to New Versions of Turbo-TRAX

To upgrade your Turbo-TRAX, you never have to repeat the steps in the three previous pages. Just perform the four steps below:

- 1) Go into Turbo-TRAX, select **File – Save Data to Disk** and save your data onto a USB key.
- 2) Quit Turbo-TRAX.
- 3) Go to turboschool.com/trax2.htm and follow screen instructions to install the latest Turbo-TRAX into **c:\traxanal**
- 4) Launch Turbo-TRAX, select **File – Load Data from Disk** and reload your data from the USB key.
